General Information United Veterans Committee of Colorado is a non-profit coalition, comprised of over 50 Colorado Veterans Organizations. By-laws require that each organization has only one (1) VOTE on formal agenda issues. Each organization should designate one Primary representative, and one Alternate representative. Some organizations designate a primary and more than one alternate, but still only have one vote. Designated representatives should be individuals who will attend scheduled meetings, and will vote in accordance with their organizational by-laws (not personal decisions or opinions). Primary will cast vote, if present. On normal house-keeping votes (non-agenda items) everyone present can vote.
